  - Yearbook

  - Boosterthon Fun Run
    - The school has decided to participate in the Boosterthon Fun Run program in May 2019. This is an 8-day program beginning with a student pep-rally on Wednesday 5/6 and ending with the fun run event on Friday 5/15.
    - Conservative profit estimates, based on the WES event, suggest a profit of \$20,000-\$24,000.
    - **Volunteers needed** to assist in event planning, fundraising and day-of-event assistance.
      - Fundraising for event t-shirts may be difficult. Many organizations in the area have already been contacted by the school for Ready Set Glow. Any ideas are appreciated.
  - Bingo Night – 1/10
    - Becky Allen and Karen vine are running this event.
  - Roll On America Event – 1/18 and 3/20
    - Myriah Zwicker is coordinating these events.
    - Unfortunately, we have only had 36 paid attendees (12 on Sat 10/12 event and 24 at the Tuesday 11/5). This means that we will have to get 89 paid attendees (125 total) at the final two events in order to earn the \$1,000.
      - It is possible to add an additional event to meet the 125 total.
  - Snowflake Dance Party – 1/31
    - Amanda Davidson is running this event.
    - Photography question
      - Veronika is proposing a change to digital only, with the cost remaining at \$10. Alternatively the print package (1- 5x7, 2- 4x6) will be increased to \$12
      - Veronika said it works way better at the other schools she does it at. The price is not enough to cover the administrative work and prints and has been well-received everywhere else because people get their pictures way faster and can print as many as they want, plus share them on social media etc.

- Increasing costs of Dance Party, Game Night and Bunny Breakfast?
  - Dance Party and Game Night are currently \$5/couple, 3 each additional child. Increase to \$5/person (child or adult)?
    - Dance Party lost \$14.72 in 2018. Last year it raised, but the DJ donated his services. This will not be the case this year.
    - Game Night lost \$247.18 and \$153.68 in the last two years.
  - Bunny Breakfast is currently \$3/person. Increase to \$5 for those over 18(??), \$3 for those over 2(??)?
    - Bunny Breakfast raised \$169.33 in 2018 and lost \$61.22 in 2019.
