Opening Remarks

• Jason Stanton, President, thanked everyone for taking their time to attend the meeting **Principal's Report**

 - Looking for more help next year, school-wide and maybe town wide
 - Tried to keep it "Staff Only"
- Piloting New Math Programs
 - Have 2 finalists the district is looking to adopt

Secretary's Report

- Tiffani Sell, Secretary, presented the December meeting minutes for approval. Minutes were approved as amended.

- Sandwich board sign damaged during Thanksgiving snowstorm. The structure is not damaged. A new sign board may be in order, but I will do my best to repair it. I will have more on this in our next meeting

Treasurer's Report

• Greg Belkin, Treasurer, is away on business, no statement yet to update

Administrative Matters

- Yearbook
 - Tiffani Sell will chair the project. Michelle Parkinson and Jason Stanton will assist. Additional Volunteers are needed to assist with a number of tasks throughout the year.
 - Tiffani has proposed the idea to the group to consider PTA purchasing Standard, softcover yearbooks for all 5th grader students - the cost would be roughly \$2000.00 (give or take from year to year)
 - Active Discussion This was not resolved so we have decided to continue the discussion at our next meeting. Please come ready to share your thoughts, ideas, or concerns with this topic.

- Pros:
 - We currently have extra funds
 - No need for those who can't afford to avoid or speak up
 - Helps give a break since 5th grade parents are also paying the cost for Nature's classroom
 - Families with multi children get a break
 - PTA gift to that graduating class
 - We can still accept donations towards this expense if chose
 - Any additional wants such as extra pages, hard cover etc. would be at expense of the students
 - May raise dedication cost
 - Prevents any students from being left out
 - We have planned to add additional fundraisers that may cover this cost
 - Those who would prefer hardcover or extras would need to pay for them
- Cons
 - Not sure that it is a cost that the PTA could sustain yearly
 - Thought if we were going to donate that amount it could go to something else such as a trip or party
 - Not sure that's fair for other grades
 - May be hard to track those who want extras may be extra work
- Boosterthon Fun Run
 - The school has decided to participate in the Boosterthon Fun Run program in May 2019. This is an 8-day program beginning with a student pep-rally on Wednesday 5/6 and ending with the fun run event on Friday 5/15.
 - Conservative profit estimates, based on the WES event, suggest a profit of \$20,000-\$24,000.
 - **Volunteers are needed** to assist in event planning, fundraising and day-of-event assistance.
 - Fundraising for event t-shirts may be difficult. Many organizations in the area have already been contracted by the school for Ready Set Glow. Any ideas are appreciated.
- Bingo Night 1/10
 - Becky Allen and Karen Vine are running this event.
 - 5 Games instead of 6 Games
 - Have lots of books & stuffed animals donated
 - Things are in good shape, staff and volunteers willing to help

- Roll-on America
 - Myriah Zwicker is coordinating this event
 - Unfortunately, we have only had 36 paid attendees (12 on Saturday 10/12 event and 24 on Tuesday 11/5). This means that we will have to get 89 paid attendees (125 Total) at the final two events in order to earn the \$1,000.
 - It is possible to add an additional event to meet the 125 total.
 - Added additional information in the flyer to inform parents in hopes to boost attendance
 - Next event Saturday 1/18/2020
- Snowflake Dance Party 1/31
 - Amanda Davidson is running this event.
 - Photography questions
 - Veronika is proposing a change to digital only, with the cost remaining at \$10. Alternatively the print package (1-5x7, 2-4x6) will be increased to \$12.
 - Veronika said it works way better at the other schools she does it at. The price is not enough to cover the administrative work and prints and has been well-received everywhere else because people get their pictures way faster and can print as many as they want, plus share them on social media etc.
 - A: Would prefer both both options if only one leave it the same with the increase
 - Flyers should go home on Monday
 - Beginning with this flyer, all future JRB event flyers will include the following information "PTA would like any interested family to be able to attend this and all PTA events. If your family is experiencing financial need and would like to request a scholarship to cover event admission, please check the box for scholarship on this form and return marked Confidential."
 - A Scholarship box will be added to every form to get it out there, where financial assistance is needed.
- Staff Appreciation Lunch 2/6
 - Jason Stanton is running this event
 - Approaches are the same as last night, adding online sign up for condiments and extras. Meals and main dishes everyone can bring anything in masses.
 - It would be great to have more crock pots and crock pot meals
- Box Tops
 - With the new policy being written regarding food as rewards and within the school classrooms changing, Brenda was wondering if we could change the BoxTop Top Collector Winner Prizes to a classroom Gift certification for \$5.00 to target. There would be 6 winners at \$5.00 each totalling \$30.00 for the year.

Thepoporn ran between \$10.00 and \$12.00 each time so it would work out to about the same year total.

- Increasing costs of Dance Party, Game Night and Bunny Breakfast?
 - Dance Party and Game Night are currently \$5/couple, 3 each additional child. Increase to \$5.00 per person (child or adult)?
 - Dance party lost \$14.72 in 2018. Last year it raised, but the DJ donated his services. This will not be the case this year
 - Game Night lost \$247.18 and \$153.68 in the last two years.
 - After discussion, the group came to consensus of \$4.00 a person and \$20.00 family max
 - Bunny Breakfast is currently \$3/person.
 - A motion made and passed to Increase to \$5 for Adults, \$3 for those over 2(??) and under free
